We have no fight with economies, marketplaces nor anyone, but to offer a place of inquiry and rest when these go awry from our own terms. We may always be a mere few who are convicted so. We welcome all who want to take up this inquiry with us, to do so, bringing their reciprocal wisdoms to our table as respected friends, colleagues and worth practitioners.
